

Is an Executive MBA right for me?

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"Is an Executive MBA right for me?"

Over the years we've helped hundreds of people answer this question.

Executive MBA program is a type of MBA with distinctive characteristics and special value to mid-career professionals on an executive career path who want to continue to work while they earn a degree. We decided to offer this brief guide to the Executive MBA degree to help prospective students become familiar with the EMBA program.

"What is an Executive MBA?"

The Executive MBA is a specific type of accredited MBA program. It is designed for working managers and professionals, with a minimum of 3 years of work experience, but 11 on average, often including prior management responsibility. The class schedule is formatted to allow students to continue working while they pursue their studies — in fact, the expectation is that they will remain employed in a position that allows them to apply what they are learning while they complete the program. Students also bring their current and prior experience into the classroom to enrich the learning experience of their fellow students. Direct personal interaction in the classroom and in study groups is considered critical to the learning experience.

"What are the benefits of an Executive MBA?"

Top Faculty

Collaborative Learning

At the executive level building partnerships, alliances and other cooperative relationships becomes very important. In the classroom and in study groups, you'll test your team building skills and learn to rely on others to help you succeed. Successful Executive MBA students learn how to share responsibilities with each other and take advantage of each others' experience and knowledge for mutual benefit — a skill directly transferable to their work.

Immediate Applicability

Applying what you learn to challenges and opportunities in the business world is essential to the Executive MBA experience. As an Executive MBA student, the workplace becomes a laboratory in which you test what you've learned in the classroom. You will have opportunities to design projects that allow you to solve real problems you face at work as you complete course requirements. The project which you will be working on with your team is **Business Plan**. During the 22-month program you will be developing an idea and reviewing the business blocks with your mentor. At the end of the program the team will defend their Business Plan project in front of the jury.

This not only enriches your education, but has a positive impact on your performance on the iob, building your confidence and business courage.

Increased Confidence

If you've developed your business skills and knowledge on the job, an Executive MBA program can help you fill in the gaps, learn the language of business and give you a firm grounding in the fundamentals of its various disciplines. Work Experience

Because the Executive MBA relies heavily on the experience of students enrolled in the program, prior work history is an important factor in the admissions process. Whatever your prior employment, a record of significant achievement is a good indicator of your ability to succeed in an Executive MBA program.

Current Employment

Executive MBA students benefit most if they're in a position that allows them to apply the knowledge and skills they develop in the classroom. This is likely to be a position with significant management responsibility. Unless they're self-employed, students most often require the support of an employer in one form or another. Support from a sponsor — typically a top manager or executive — is critical. Executive MBA students may receive

financial support from their employers. Sponsoring companies often use Executive MBA programs as part of their management development or succession planning programs.

Career Goals

It's important to define how you expect to use the knowledge and skills you'll develop in an Executive MBA program to further your career goals. Are there specific job opportunities within your company or industry that an Executive MBA would help you qualify for? Do you plan to start your own business? Understanding how an Executive MBA will help you achieve your specific goals will give you confidence in committing to a rigorous program and position you as a successful candidate for admission.

Motivation and Temperament

Executive MBA students possess energy, drive and ambition that separate them from the pack. Typically, a high percentage of Executive MBA students are hard-driving, take-charge personalities who are challenged to share leadership responsibilities in study groups and team projects. "How can I fit this program into my busy schedule?"

COTRUGLI Executive MBA program is designed to make it possible to allow students to remain productive and perform at a high level on the job. Therefore, we have created a schedule to take an average 2 days a months off work. Modules are organized typically from Friday to Sunday once a month. There are some modules that are more intense and take up more preparation time and days off work, but all participants receive a schedule more then one year ahead so they can plan they activities.

Some course content and other services may be delivered online, to allow students to progress in their studies and interact with students and instructors at times that are most convenient to them.

Projects and other assignments may be assigned to study groups where the group can divide responsibilities and delegate tasks to individual members.

Nevertheless, Executive MBA program will demand a significant amount of time and effort from each student. Many report that the experience forces them to become highly efficient in managing their time, and that this is indeed an important skill they develop during the program.

If you enroll in an Executive MBA program, you will have to manage the impact on both your job and your personal life. You can manage the impact on your work by setting clear expectations about your schedule with your supervisor and colleagues, and delegating some of your responsibilities. Managing the impact on your personal life often means routinely setting aside blocks of time for individual study and meetings (real or virtual) with your study group. Because your employer will likely expect you to contribute at the same level on the job, most of the demand will be on your personal time. However, most students find that it's possible to maintain an active and satisfying family life while they're enrolled in an Executive MBA program.

TUITION FEE is € 18.000 + VAT (23%)

It is possible to suggest the installments by your own terms. However, the first installment has to be put down before the first module, and the last installment before the last module.

Also, loans are available in Croatian banks.

"How do I apply?"
